

INFORMATION CLAUSE

In accordance with Article 13 of EP and Council Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter: "GDPR"), please note that:

- Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of responding to the message you

 consent (basis under Article 6(1)(a) GDPR);
- We will keep your contact details until you withdraw your consent, but no longer than until the end of the calendar year following the year in which you have last contacted us.
- In certain situations, we have the right to transfer your data if this is necessary for us to perform our services. We will transfer data to the following categories of entities: persons authorised by us, our employees and associates who need to have access to the data to perform their duties, data processors to whom we outsource this task and other data recipients;
- We do not intend to transfer your data outside the European Economic Area.
- You have the right to: request access to and obtain a copy of your personal data from the Controller; the right to rectification, erasure or restriction of processing; the right to object to processing; and the right to data portability. Please note that before we can apply your rights, we will need to ascertain that you are who you say you are, i.e. identify you appropriately;
- You have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Data Protection Authority
